A BILL To abolish the Space Force as an Armed Force, and for other purposes.
1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4 This Act may be cited as the "No Militarization of
5 Space Act".
6 SEC. 2. ABOLISHMENT OF THE SPACE FORCE AS AN ARMED
7 FORCE.
8 (a) In General.—As soon as practicable after sub-

9 mitting to the congressional defense committees the report

required under subsection (c)(2), but not later than one year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense, acting through the Secretary of the Air 4 Force, shall abolish the Space Force as an Armed Force within the Department of the Air Force in accordance 6 with this section. (b) CESSATION OF CERTAIN TRANSFER ACTIVI-7 8 TIES.—During the period preceding the abolishment of the Space Force pursuant to subsection (a), the Secretary of 10 Defense may not transfer any authorities, duties, functions, missions, personnel, units, facilities, or assets from 11 12 another Armed Force to the Space Force. 13 (c) Plan for Transfer.— 14 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after 15 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary 16 of Defense shall complete the development of a plan 17 to transfer all authorities, duties, functions, mis-18 sions, personnel, units, facilities, and assets from the 19 Space Force to the appropriate commands of the 20 Armed Forces. (2) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 21 22 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, 23 the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the con-24 gressional defense committees a report on the plan 25 described in paragraph (1).

1	(d) Dissolution of the Space Force.—
2	(1) Transfer to air force space com-
3	MAND.—Except as provided by paragraph (2), effec-
4	tive upon the abolishment of the Space Force, there
5	are transferred to the Air Force Space Command
6	the authorities, duties, functions, missions, per-
7	sonnel, units, facilities, and assets of the Space
8	Force.
9	(2) Transfer outside of air force space
10	COMMAND.—Effective upon the abolishment of the
11	Space Force, any authorities, duties, functions, mis-
12	sions, personnel, units, facilities, and assets trans-
13	ferred to the Space Force from a command of an
14	Armed Force other than the Air Force Space Com-
15	mand shall be returned to such other command.
16	(e) Repeal of Relevant Laws.—Effective upon
17	the abolishment of the Space Force, the following subtitles
18	are repealed and any provisions of law amended or re-
19	pealed by such subtitles are restored or revived as if such
20	subtitles had not been enacted:

4	(f) References in Law.—Effective upon the abol-
5	ishment of the Space Force, any reference to the Space
6	Force in any law, regulation, map, document, record, or
7	other paper of the United States shall be deemed to be
8	a reference to the Air Force Space Command.
9	(g) Congressional Defense Committees De-
10	FINED.—The term "congressional defense committees"
11	has the meaning given such term in section 101(a)(16)
12	of title 10, United States Code.
