Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the **Point Reyes Workforce Housing** project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is **County of Marin**, located at P.O. Box 273, Point Reyes Station, CA 94956.

The funding would be used for affordable housing initiative led by the Community Land Trust Association of West Marin (CLAM), in partnership with the County of Marin. The project will provide urgently needed housing for up to 50 low-income residents—primarily agricultural and service-sector workers—who are at immediate risk of displacement due to Point Reyes National Seashore ranch closures and substandard housing conditions on other private ranches in West Marin.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it directly addresses an urgent housing crisis in a vulnerable rural region, marked by high rates of income inequality. By investing in urgently needed housing for low-income residents at risk of displacement, the project helps prevent homelessness, preserve essential jobs for the region's Agricultural sector.
