## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the commitment of the Congress to the Paris Agreement.

Whereas the challenge of climate change requires a global effort;

Whereas the international community must work to both reduce greenhouse gas emissions as well as prepare for the effects of climate change;

Whereas the United States plays an indispensable role in global leadership;

Whereas the Paris Agreement sets goals that are not only achievable but necessary in order to move towards a pathway to limit temperature rise to below 2 degrees Celsius; and

Whereas the United States is stronger when joining with  
global efforts to address climate change: Now, therefore,  
be it
